

Public Information Resources Fourmile Fire

Boulder County has established an assistance center for people affected by the Fourmile Canyon wildfire.

The center is located at Boulder County's Sundquist Building ([map location](#)), 3482 N. Broadway in Boulder.

The assistance center is offering the following counseling and support services to victims of the fire:

- Food and basic needs assistance
- Longer-term housing options for people who have lost their homes
- Insurance claim advice
- Mental health
- Medical case management
- Senior services for those age 60 and older
- Coordination with local nonprofit organizations to provide clothing and other basic needs

The center is being staffed by Boulder County, the Red Cross and the Mental Health Center of Boulder County. A call center is also operational there and can be contacted at 303-441-3560.
