Hose (4) and hydrant (1) wrenches	Mounted on each pump panel		
Water tank level	Full (four lights)		
Inlet and outlet covers	On and secure		
Cold weather	Open all drains. Remove, drain and replace inlet and outlet covers. Drain auxiliary pump. Blow out hose reel.

<b>UNDER THE HOOD</b>			
Engine oil level	15-30 or 15-45 multi-purpose oil		
Engine air filter	Visual check and reset flow minder		
Coolant	Check level in overflow tank		
Power steering fluid	Fill as needed (ATF)		
Brake fluid	Fill as needed (brake fluid)		
Clutch fluid (right next to brake fluid reservoir)	Fill as needed (brake fluid)		
Washer fluid	Fill as needed		
Belts and hoses	Clean, tight, good condition		
Batteries	Terminals tight and corrosion-free		
<b>UNDER THE HOSE BED (complete in January, April, July, October, and after significant pump/compressor use)</b>			
Primer pump oil	Fill with eco-friendly coolant		
Compressor oil	Check sight glass		
Compressor air filters	Visual check and knock the dust off (there are two of them)		
<b>PUMP, COMPRESSOR, FOAM AND WATER DELIVERY</b>			
Pump panel	Exercise all valves and drains. Drains open/closed based on weather protocol.		
Pump and compressor	Recirculate water and run compressor. Flow CAFS through booster line and flush with water.		
Pressure relief valve	Exercise, set at 200 psi		
Primer	Exercise, ensure it pulls a vacuum		
Foam tank	Minimum ¾ full		
Hard suction (2)	Clean, stowed, gaskets in place		
Hose reel	Stowed, blown out in cold weather.		
Suction strainer	Clean and stowed, gasket in place		
<b>OTHER</b>			
Radios and hand lanterns	Remove from charger and turn on at beginning of monthly check. When done, verify batteries still working. Return to charger.		
Tires	All tires at 100 psi		
Ground and pump panel lights	Working		
Cooler	Stocked with water, sport drink.		
Saw	Gas, oil, tools, chaps. Start and run.		
Gansners (4) and Engineer pack	All present. Pre-connected E-pack has 1.5" wye and nozzle.		
Extinguisher	Gauge shows full. Loosen powder.		
Med kit	Check O2 level.		
Backpack pumps (4)	Clean, empty and stowed		
Wildland hand tools	Clean, sharp, taped and stowed		
Winch control	Exercise winch		
Inventory cab and exterior	January, April, July, October		
Inventory left side compartments	February, May, August, November		
Inventory right side compartments	March, June, September, December		

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
